1. Schedule Reports

a. Core

- i. Added a new Accounting Calendar validation check to ensure the calendar provided encompasses the entire project file's period of performance. It applies to the three reports that require a calendar to be established: the BEI, CEI, and Major Event Summary reports
- ii. Corrected issues causing reports to crash if they were determined to only have one row of data to report
- iii. Added validation check to warn the user of an incomplete Settings Profile as they navigate from the Report Settings page to the Include Reports page

b. Calendar Management

- i. Added an indeterminate import progress bar that appears during the import process to indicate the application is busy

c. Look Ahead Report

- i. Corrected issues requiring intervals to be entered in ascending order by their interval end date; intervals can now be entered in any order

d. Major Event Summary Report

- i. Updated report to require the Accounting Calendar. This report will no longer be available on Settings Profiles without an accounting calendar established

e. Slipped Tasks Report

- i. Updated the report to require a CAM % Complete field mapping in the active Settings Profile to be run

2. Title Case Text

- a. Corrected issue causing Project crashes on attempting to edit a “Text to Exclude from Title Case” entry

3. Manage Exclusions

- a. Updated the window behavior when the Settings Profile does not have an Exclusions field mapping. The window will direct the user to populate the setting instead of disabling all the window controls with no indication as to why it can’t be used

1. Inspect Schedule

- a. Updated the way the schedule inspection considers inactive tasks. Now, the inspection will report on inactive tasks that meet the check criteria unless the task is formally excluded from the inspection via the Manage Exclusions utility.
- b. Corrected errors that would be encountered by users operating within the Standard editions of Microsoft Project

2. Schedule Reports

- a. Added additional validation for the report template file extension to ensure it is an Excel file with an extension of “.xls”, “.xlsx”, or “.xlsm”

3. Settings

- a. Corrected issue where the Exclusion field setting would not operate when set to utilize the Notes field

4. Navigate Tasks

- a. Corrected issue causing task dependencies’ lag text to not display

5. Manage Exclusions

- a. Updated to provide more feedback messaging to notify users if no Exclusions field mapping is available in the active settings profile and how many tasks were modified during the Add and Remove processes
